

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### When are applications due?

Application Deadline: 12/10/2024

We encourage families to apply ASAP in order to schedule the parents interview.

#### What is the class size at Buckley?

The (student:faculty) ratio is 8:1. We enroll approximately 40–44 students in 2 sections. We have 4 kindergarten teachers.

#### Is financial assistance available?

Approximately 1 in 5 students receives financial assistance. For the 2024–25 school year, Buckley budgeted nearly \$6 million in assistance. Each year, there are more applications than available grant money so apply early!
